We continue to see people being fed not only physically but also spiritually and emotionally. Moving forward, all TKC operations will be run out of our new headquarters in Cherry Hill, NJ. We are excited to see how God will continue to open doors for us as we look to serve as many people as we can.



Our [Outdoor Ministry](#) is preparing for the second annual [Camp Conquerors](#) that will be held in North Dakota this summer. We had 45 children at our first camp, and we're excited to see that number grow substantially this year. Campers will be exposed to several outdoor activities including swimming, canoeing, horseback riding, archery, and more. Our favorite part of camp is watching confidence grow in all the children and seeing our counselors take pride in guiding them in their faith.



Meanwhile, the [Haiti Sports Complex](#) continues to take shape. With the completion of the multipurpose building only weeks away, our focus has shifted to the fields adjacent to the building. We are working with local contractors to find economical ways to get turf on the ground as soon as possible without jeopardizing the scope and expense of the entire project. In the interim, programming will begin in the multipurpose building, and we are excited to see the hope that sports will bring to the people of Haiti.
