CARSON WENTZ AO1 FOUNDATION RAISES \$95,607 ON GIVING HEARTS DAY 2020

PHILADELPHIA - The [Carson Wentz AO1 Foundation](#) has announced that a total of \$95,607 was raised as part of [Giving Hearts Day](#) (GHD) on February 13, 2020. GHD is a 24-hour fundraising event for charities in North Dakota and northwest Minnesota, which has raised more than \$90 million since its inception in 2008.

The AO1 Foundation would like to thank the nearly 500 individuals and businesses who chose to support its mission on GHD. All funds raised will support the [Outdoor Ministry](#), which aims to serve children in the Midwest with physical challenges, life-threatening illnesses (past and present) and the underserved in order to “foster a genuine passion for outdoor activities and bring people closer to God through discipleship.”

The Outdoor Ministry is divided into two programs: [Camp Conquerors](#) and [Mountain Movers](#).

Camp Conquerors provides children with an opportunity to experience the outdoors like they never have before and exposes them to a gospel-centered curriculum designed to develop an appreciation for the outdoors, improve self-worth and self-confidence and to establish healthy relationships. The Mountain Movers program offers children once in a lifetime hunting and fishing experiences while mentoring them in the Gospel through small group discussions.

The AO1 Foundation has provided more than 130 outdoor experiences for children through the Outdoor Ministry since its launch in 2017.

In total, Giving Hearts Day 2020 raised a preliminary, record-breaking figure of \$19,087,916 for nearly 500 charities in the region. The event also surpassed its previous best with a total of 75,590 donations made by 34,565 donors. GHD is co-hosted by the Dakota Medical Foundation, the Impact Foundation and the Alex Stern Family Foundation.
