Each gift included an Amazon Fire HD 8" tablet with a cover, a custom AO1 drawstring bag, Philadelphia Eagles sunglasses and a Christmas card signed by Carson Wentz. The grocery boxes, provided by [Thy Kingdom Crumb](#), contained pancake mix, oatmeal, cereal, bagels, juice, hot chocolate and more.

The AO1 Foundation partnered with the Philadelphia Eagles to host a similar outreach event at Lawncrest Recreation Center in 2019. However, to ensure all COVID-19 safety protocols were met, this event was modified in 2020.
