
In 2022, the A01 Foundation saw significant growth and impact across our ministries. Last year was the first full year of operation for Thy Kingdom Crumb in Indianapolis, and we are so proud of how it has served the community. Thy Kingdom Crumb: Philadelphia has continued to feed people physically and spiritually through curbside pickup events, and the truck is back on the streets. The Outdoor Ministry continued its upward trajectory by hosting two full weeks of Camp Conquerors and nearly doubling the number of Mountain Movers adventures in 2022. Finally, more than 13,000 children utilized the Haiti Sports Complex through our partnership with Mission of Hope.

In this report, you will read stories of adults and children whose lives have been changed forever in the last year because of your support. To all those who have given their time, resources and energy, we say thank you! We are praying for God's provision in 2023, and with your support, we will continue to accomplish our mission together!

Thy Kingdom Crumb exists to remind people that they are seen, valued and loved by addressing the issue of food insecurity. Through the distribution of free, high-quality food with excellence and community outreach, we want to help all people tangibly experience the unconditional love of God.

The original Thy Kingdom Crumb food truck launched in Philadelphia in 2018, where it continues to serve the community. This ministry expanded to Indianapolis in December 2021.

More than 100.000 meals have been served. and thousands of free Biblical resources have been distributed through Thy Kingdom Crumb.





This chart represents the number of meals served in <u>Indianapolis</u> by month in 2022. After launching in December 2021, we saw tremendous growth in our first full year of operation. We know the significance of food during the holidays, so we strongly emphasized serving the community during the winter months.



As our longest-running food truck, <u>Thy Kingdom Crumb: Philadelphia</u> has been serving the community since 2018. This chart reflects the percentage of meals served by year. While 2022 wasn't our highest total, we are proud the highest number of meals served came during the COVID-19 pandemic when our community needed the most support.





"Fostering a genuine passion for the outdoors and bringing people closer to God through discipleship."

The <u>Outdoor Ministry</u> was created in 2018 to serve children with life-threatening illnesses and other life-altering medical situations through two programs: <u>Mountain</u> Movers and Camp Conquerors.

Mountain Movers provides once-in-a-lifetime hunting, fishing and other outdoor adventures where children are taught ethical practices and can enjoy the beauty of God's creation. As part of each adventure, children are mentored in the Gospel through small group discussions.

Camp Conquerors is a free camp that allows children to experience the outdoors in a setting designed to uplift them spiritually, emotionally and mentally through worship, biblical teaching and small group discussion. Campers are exposed to activities to help them conquer fear and overcome adversity.

Through these programs and continued discipleship, we will effectively demonstrate the love of God to these children and encourage them in their walk with Christ.

Each year, all Outdoor Ministry families gather together for a day of fellowship, meals, games and awards. We provide a hotel to all families in attendance.





Discipleship

On each adventure, we read daily devotionals, engage in spiritual conversations and pray together. Camp includes worship, biblical teachings and small group discussions.



This map represents the states we traveled to for a <u>Mountain Movers</u> adventure in 2022. Our staff took 39 children to 19 states, traveling 37,342 miles throughout the year.



This chart represents the number of children involved in Mountain Movers and <u>Camp Conquerors</u> since the inception of the <u>Outdoor Ministry</u> in 2018. Both programs have seen continued growth over the past five years. We have taken all necessary steps, including adding staff, volunteers and camps to continue to serve even more children moving forward.





For the <u>Outdoor Ministry</u>, 2022 was one of our best years yet. At the beginning of the year, we formed an incredible partnership with the 4-H Foundation and found a new home for <u>Camp Conquerors</u>. The new location provides a perfect environment for children to build relationships with each other and creates an atmosphere for us to share the gospel through worship, biblical teaching and small group discussions.

Mountain Movers continues to be one of our most fruitful programs and allows us to form an even greater connection with the children involved in our programs. Last year, we launched a handful of new events while maintaining established relationships with children and their families. These events included the inaugural Mountain Movers Family Night, Christmas Party and a summer hangout.

We are excited for a new year of programming to reach and impact even more children throughout the Midwest!

"A partnership to bring hope to a nation through sport."

The AO1 Foundation created and built the Haiti Sports Complex through a partnership with Mission of Hope.

The complex, including an 18,000 sq. foot multipurpose building with two sport courts and locker rooms and a full-size turf soccer field, was opened at a ribbon-cutting ceremony on June 2, 2021.

Since then, Mission of Hope staff has hosted numerous basketball and soccer camps at the sports complex. At each camp, children receive a nutritious meal and fresh water, develop their skills through coaching and are discipled in the Gospel.

Through the partnership with Mission of Hope, the AO1 Foundation will continue to help fund, maintain and run the Haiti Sports Complex.







LIG LESPWA

Lig Lespwa (League of Hope) was launched in 2022 to provide skill development, character development, consistent access, nutrition and discipleship opportunities through the Haiti Sports Complex.

The first-ever Lig Lespwa Championship game was held at the end of the summer on the turf soccer field. The game was between Minoterie and Cabaret (two local villages near the sports complex). The game was close and came down to penalty kicks to decide the champion. Cabaret came out on top to win the summer session of Lig Lespwa.

Over 13,000 children utilized the facility through Lig Lespwa and various day camps! Even though the country has seen a recent increase in gang violence, we are praying the sports complex will continue to be a safe place for children to grow their skills and hear the Gospel message.



Why Haiti?

After visiting on a mission trip, Carson felt a calling for the AO1 Foundation to establish a footprint in Haiti and decided to create a partnership with Mission of Hope.



Living in Poverty

Over 54% of Haitians live in poverty, and the country has faced severe political corruption, civil unrest and several natural disasters in recent


As I reflect on 2022, I am proud of my team in Haiti and all the hard work they have put in with launching Lig Lespwa in the spring. One of my favorite moments was seeing our bleachers full as children came to watch the championship game between our local schools. To me, this photo enraptured a glimpse of the impact the sports complex has on the community and the joy it brings. For many, it will be a day they will never forget. I still have one member of the first Lig Lespwa Championship who talks about that day.

Another highlight was our growth in discipling students through Lig Lespwa and working with Mission of Hope schools. We built consistency with students and allowed our staff to develop stronger relationships with them. Our team dug deeper into what it means to follow Christ. My last highlight was our summer camp, where we hosted 100-400 children daily. Through those camps, we had 90 children accept Jesus as their Lord and Savior. Those acceptances remind me of the real purpose behind everything we do.


